



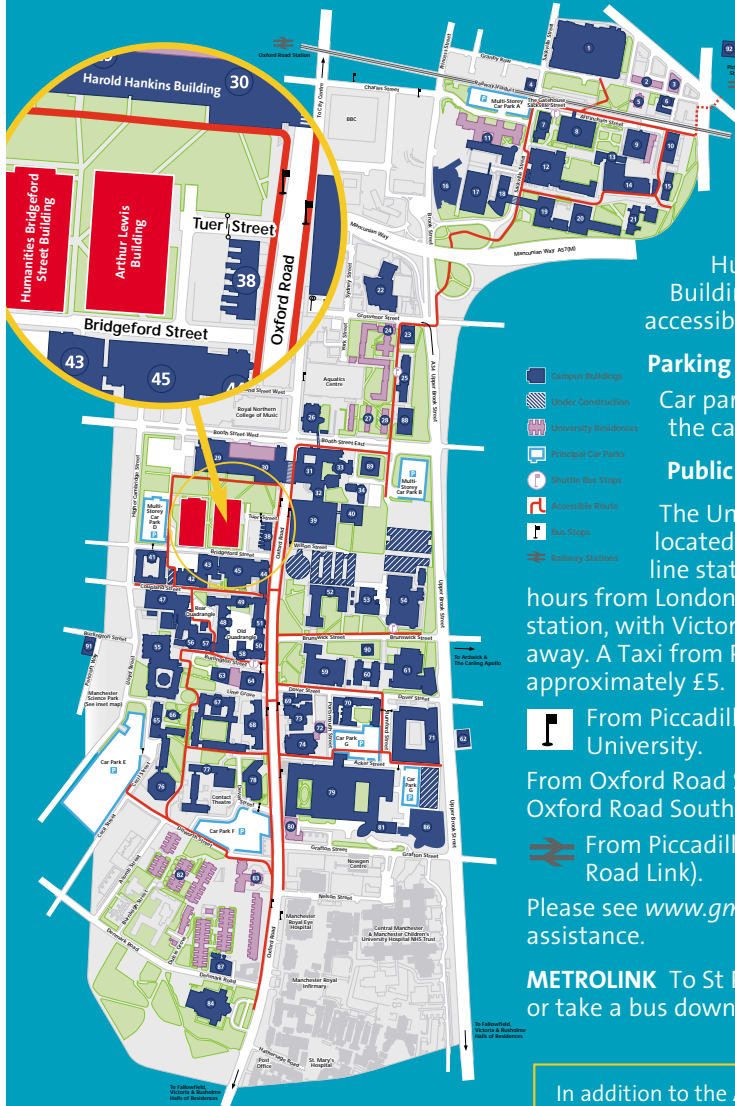

Directions

The Arthur Lewis Building is situated off Oxford Road with access either from Tuer Street on the right or Bridgeford Street on the left. The main entrance is opposite the Humanities Bridgeford Street Building. The building is fully accessible to disabled people.

Parking

Car parking is available throughout the campus and marked [P].

Public transport

The University of Manchester is located close to both Piccadilly main line station (about two and a half hours from London) and Oxford Road train station, with Victoria train station a little further away. A Taxi from Piccadilly Station is approximately £5.

From Oxford Road Station: All buses along Oxford Road Southbound.

 From Piccadilly Train Station: 147 (Oxford Road Link).
